I'd like to welcome you back to school at the all-new Justice Preparatory Academy.

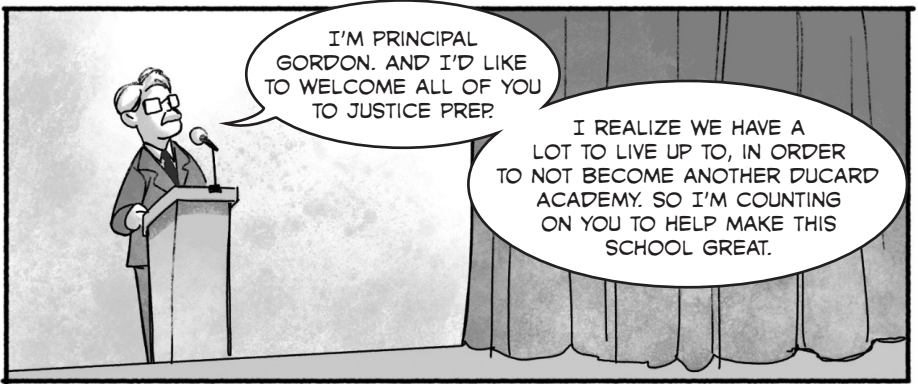
