## A Clifford Party Idea

### Crazy Collars

What you'll need:

Markers

Scissors

Glue

Several yards of plain white cloth ribbon (one foot per child)

Glitter, sequins, beads and/or other arts and crafts supplies

Posterboard

Heavy paper or cardboard cut into 2-inch circles

Single-hole punch

Yarn or string

Stapler

Each child will design a collar and tags for a stuffed animal (one that they bought or one you've supplied as a party favor). Start by measuring a bit of ribbon around the toy's neck to determine length. Ends should overlap about an inch. Cut the ribbon.

Let the child decorate the ribbon with markers, beads, sequins etc. While glue is drying, children can make tags.

Child can select one of the cardboard circles. Have child name the animal (if it doesn't already have one) and write that in the middle of both sides of the tag. Child can then decorate around the edges.

Once tag is decorated, punch a hole near the top of the tag. Run a piece of ribbon or string through the whole and tie in a loop. Run the finished collar through the loop. Wrap the collar around the stuffed pet animal's neck and staple together.
