Doggie Deli

Create kid-size sandwiches with the help of fun cookie cutters. Make simple peanut butter and jelly, balogna, or grilled cheese, and then cut out animal or even dog bone shapes with the cookie cutters. Set out bowls of animal crackers, gummy fish, and other animal candy.

Dog Biscuit Cookies

You can do this as a party activity, or pre-party for serving if you choose. Roll out refrigerated sugar cookie dough with a rolling pin. Cut "dog biscuits" with the bone-shaped cookie cutters. Bake the cookies according to package directions. Frost when cool or decorate with red sprinkles before baking. Have each child take home the cookie cutter as a favor.

Doggone Cake

Decorate a traditional round birthday cake with small, clean plastic toy dogs/puppies (found at toy stores party supply stores). When you cut slices, make sure each child gets a puppy on their plate!

Helpful Hint: This can also be an activity done early in the party. The kids can decorate the cookies first and then the cookies can bake during the party. Your guests will love to eat the results later!
