## Birthday Party Games

Cat, Cat, Dog!

This game is a variation on the game Duck, Duck, Goose. To play, kids sit down in a circle facing each other. One child is "it" and walks around the circle. As they walk around, they tap the other children's heads and say whether they are a "cat" or "dog". Once someone is tagged the "dog" they get up and try to chase "it" around the circle. The dog must tag "it" before they are able to sit down in the "dog's" spot.

If the dog is not able to do this, they become "it" for the next round and play continues. If they do tap the "it" person, the person tagged has to sit in the center of the circle. Then the dog becomes "it" for the next round. The person in the middle

can't leave until another person is tagged and sent to the center of the circle.

## Hot dog!

This game is a variation on the game Hot Potato. To play, the children stand in a circle and pass a small stuff Clifford (or any other stuff dog) around the circle to music (use something fun and up tempo). Someone not playing the game (a parent or helper) stops the music suddenly. The person left holding the "Hot Dog" is out. It's fun to pretend that the beanbag is a very, very HOT DOG!
