About the Author

Born in Nigeria to a Nigerian father and a Ukrainian mother, Akim Aliu spent years of his youth in Africa and Ukraine before moving to Toronto. A hockey prodigy, Akim was drafted into the NHL as a teenager and played for the Calgary Flames. The systemic racism, hazing, and abuse he faced during his time in the OHL and NHL have fueled his passion to make sure all kids have access to be safe playing the sport they love, no matter their background.

In May 2020, Akim wrote an article for the Players' Tribune entitled "<u>Hockey is Not for Everyone</u>," detailing the racism and violence he endured as a black athlete in hockey. He has since partnered with the Time to Dream Foundation and the Hockey Diversity Alliance to help their mission to eradicate racism and intolerance in hockey, and continues to play hockey professionally in Europe.





The Story Behind the Story

When I was in grade six, my friends are I were part of a pass-around diary. Instead of passing notes, we wrote down our thoughts, feelings, worries, and plans and discussed them at great length in a padded journal. I still have one of these diaries and I am struck by how honest we were with each other. It became a safe space for us to discuss everything from academic concerns to questions about tampons. In the diary, we could say things that were too hard to say aloud. In P.S. Tell No One I wanted to recreate that safe space. In the characters of Twix, Hoops, MP and Sunny, I hear echoes of myself, my friends, and the kids I meet at school visits on a regular basis.

As I started to write P.S. Tell No One, the updated Ontario Sex Ed curriculum was scrapped by the provincial government and a snitch line was set up encouraging parents to call in if they thought their child's teacher was teaching the discarded, more inclusive curriculum. Suddenly P.S. Tell No One felt more urgent. Where do kids go if they can't talk to their parents or their teachers about menstruation, period products, or consent? When kids have questions, especially sensitive ones, they turn to books. My hope is that P.S. Tell No One will be a life raft for a new generation of kids who find themselves treading in the rocky waters of puberty. By packing it full of humour, nitty-gritty facts, and real talk, my hope is that P.S. Tell No One is the kind of book kids will pass on to each other and say, "You HAVE to read this!".
