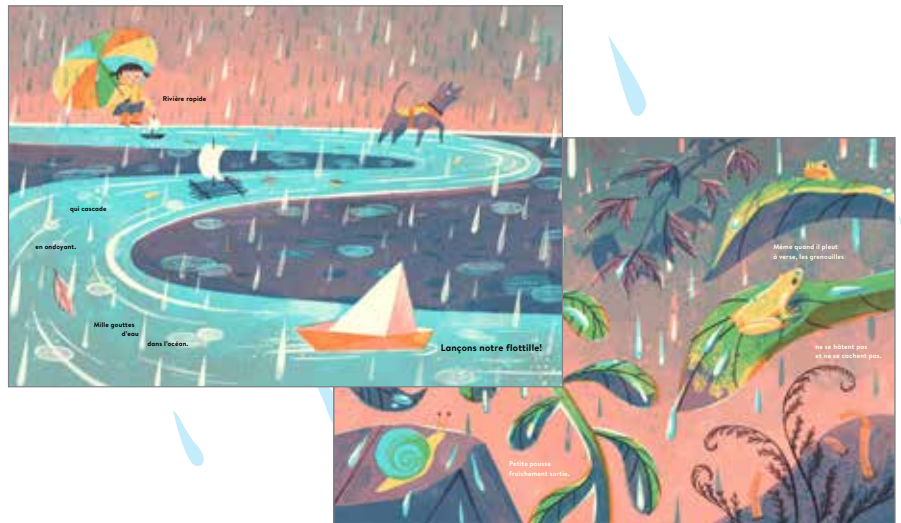
This colourful picture book with lyrical prose and soft illustrations brings readers on a journey from rain to shining sun.
