She also was short-listed for Mr. Christie's Book Award. She has written and illustrated over 30 books for children in both French and English including *Not Me (Pas moi)*, *Everybody! (Tout le monde!* and *It's My Body! (C'est mon corps!)*. Elise lives in Montreal, Quebec.

How Does Stress Work?

When you find yourself in a stressful situation, your body quickly begins to respond. This reaction is known as the stress response. You might also hear it referred to as an adrenalin rush or the fight-or-flight reaction.

Your brain sends chemical signals to the adrenal glands, where the hormones adrenalin and cortisol are produced. Then these hormones circulate through your body, affecting most of your organs.

Your heart and lungs send extra blood and oxygen to your brain and limbs. Your senses of sight and hearing sharpen. Stored glucose (sugar) and fats flood into your bloodstream, fuelling a burst of energy. Your muscles tense to guard against injury and/or to prepare for escape.

All of these adaptations have evolved to help you react faster to a threat. You can see and hear better, think faster and run away with superhuman speed, or fight with superhuman strength if you have to.

Fight-or-flight

It takes **about an hour** for extra adrenalin to be flushed out of your body.

The cerebral cortex is the part of the brain where thinking and decision making happens. The amygdala is where we process emotions. When triggered by a stressful event or thought, the amygdala sends a chemical message to the hypothalamus, the brain's "mission control center." When it kicks into gear, it triggers the stress response.

Because the stress response bypasses the cerebral cortex, you can react more quickly than usual without hesitating or overthinking. For the same reason, people often find it difficult to think clearly or rationally while under stress.

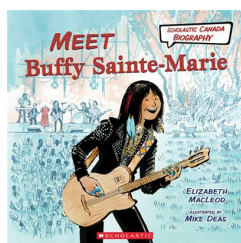

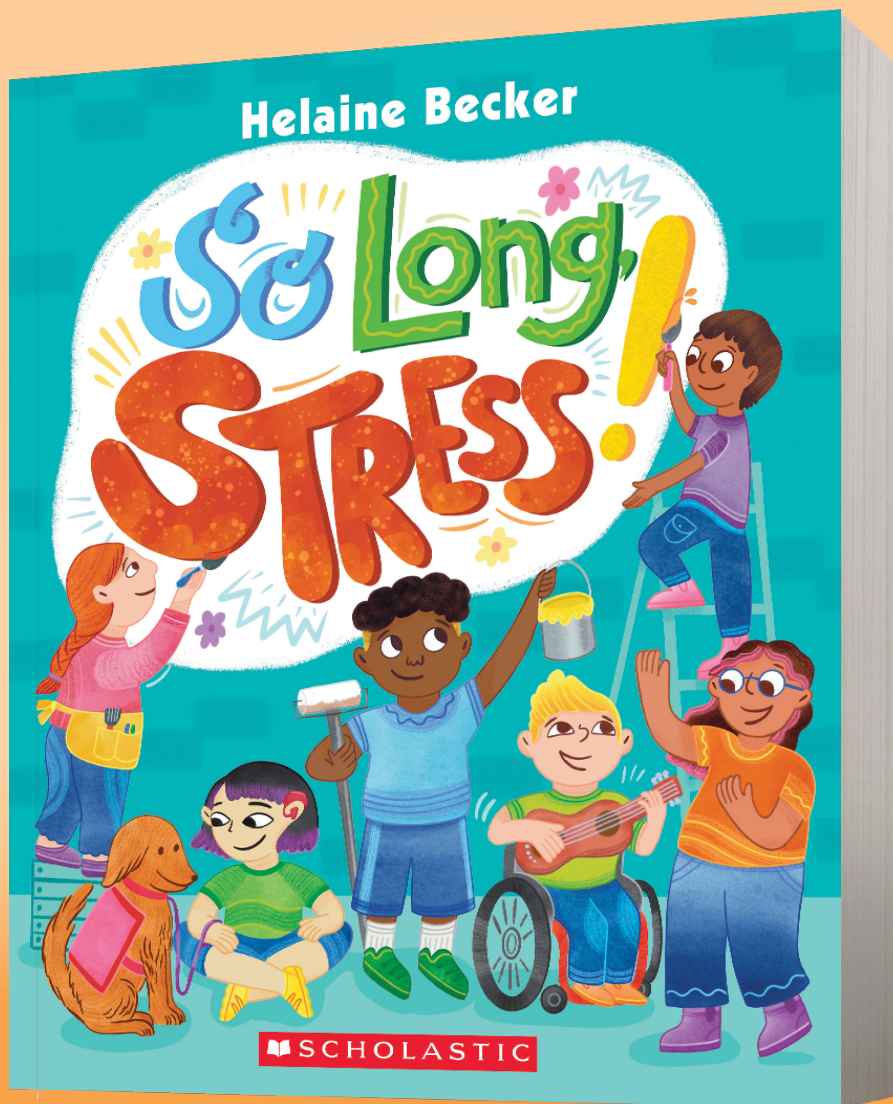
