Nibi's Water Song (Dual Language)

Nibi is the Anishinaabemowin word for water. In *Nibi a soif, très soif* an Indigenous girl searches for clean water to drink. Though she is faced with repeated obstacles, Nibi's joyful and determined energy becomes a catalyst for change and action as her community, and then in widening circles the country and government, rally around her to make clean drinking water available for all. In a story perfectly levelled for young readers, there is a strong underlying message that even when a problem seems too large to face, every bit that everyone does helps. And inaction in the face of a wrong is not an option.

Sunshine Quem Tenasco, an Anishinabeg activist for clean water, has an amazing optimistic spirit that shines through her writing. He became a surgeon, helping soldiers in World War I. After the war, he practiced family medicine and taught at a nearby university. But Fred still wanted to help people with diabetes.

One night he was struck by a big idea — a whole new way to treat the disease. Fred convinced a professor at the University of Toronto to give him a lab and an assistant: Charles Best. They worked long hours and finally developed insulin. To this day, insulin is still the only treatment for diabetes. It has saved the lives of millions of people around the world.

ELIZABETH MACLEOD is the author of many Canadian nonfiction titles, including the *Canada Close Up* series titles *Canada's Trees* and *Canadian Money* in addition to the award-winning *Biographie en images* series and *Canada Year-By-Year*.
