

The diary format means that there are no formal chapters or sections in the book. Divide the diary into chapters or sections and create a title for each. Use one of the following formats to display your new "chapter" book.



A Quilt

Create a paper quilt square for each chapter you've identified. Write the title and include an appropriate illustration on each square.

A Story Pie

Cut a large circle from oak tag paper, about 30 cm in diameter. On one side, write the title of the diary and create a collage or illustration for the main theme of the diary. Divide the other side into as many "slices" as you have chapters. On each slice, write a short summary of that section of the diary.

A Step Book

Stack four pieces of letter-size paper on top of each other. Stagger them as shown by about 1 cm each. Fold up the sheets from the bottom to 1 cm below the top sheet. Press the fold and staple it. Now you have a booklet with a top sheet for a title and illustration, and seven flaps or steps to write section summaries.
