The Liste des souhaits de la classe is the best way to ensure your students are always able to explore the books they want to read. This program is an excellent way for families to encourage their child to read more, while filling their classroom library with the best in children's literature.

Five easy steps to create Classroom Wish Lists:



Host a Festival du Livre Preview

Use the Teacher Preview Invitations (found in scholastic.ca/festival/resources) and share the date and time of your event! If they cannot attend, they can still browse the Festival du Livre to see what new titles are available or visit our Featured Books page online.



Create a Wish List Display

Ask your volunteers to create a Wish List display area in a prominent spot at the Festival. At the centre of your display, include the Wish List Poster found in this kit.



Fill out Wish Lists

As teachers browse the titles at the Festival and online, ask them to fill in the books that would be a perfect fit for their classroom library! Collect the lists for your display. The invite included with this kit includes a "Return By" date.



Share the Initiative

During the Festival, draw customers' attention to the Wish List display so they can view their child's Classroom Wish List. Once they've purchased the titles they'd like to donate, you can adhere a Book Plate to the book(s).



Deliver the great new books to teachers!
