## 10 EPIC ACTIVITIES

- 1. Design a postage stamp to celebrate one of the important Canadians or events in the book.
- 2. Pretend you're one of the famous people in the book and write a letter to your best friend telling about your colossal achievement.
- **3.** Draw or make a collage of one of the colossal events in the book.
- 4. Canadian John McCrae's poem In Flαnders Fields is recited every Remembrance Day. Draw a picture or write five sentences about what you do to mark this important day.
- 5. Have you ever tasted poutine? Why did you like it or not? Make up an unusual poutine recipe and explain why people would like it.
- **6.** Draw a picture of you having a vacation anywhere in Canada. What was memorable about the experience?
- 7. Make a flag of yourself. Think of colours and symbols that represent you. If you like hockey, you could include that. If you like to draw, include that. Give your personal flag a name.
- 8. Research the name of your city, province or town. Write up what the name means and a little about its history. Present your information to your class.
- 9. Confederation Bridge links Prince Edward Island with mainland Canada. Brainstorm with a friend and write out at least five other names for the bridge.
- 10. Why do you think people are still fascinated with the *Titαnic*? Name one other ship disaster and tell about it in two paragraphs.

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
